STREET TACO COMPETITION VENDOR RULES

The competition will begin promptly at 10:30am and each vendor will be assigned a time slot to submit their street taco for judging for "Best Street Taco". The public will determine the "Most Popular Street Taco" winner.

Attendees upon entry will receive 5 street taco tickets, 1 ticket = 1 free street taco. The taco vendor with the most taco tickets at the end of the event will win the title of "Most Popular Street Taco". Attendees will receive no more than 5 tickets but are able to purchase more tacos for \$1 each.

All street tacos are to be served for \$1. Other food items can be sold at the vendor's discretion.

No special or "made to order" items allowed.

Cilantro, onions and salsa will be the only acceptable optional add-on items.

If you are competing in the judged "Best Street Taco" competition, your restaurant can submit only **one entry**.

Eligible entries for "Best Street Taco" can be chicken, beef, pork or seafood.

You may serve more than one type of taco from your vendor space as well as other food items.

No alcoholic beverages will be allowed for sale by any vendor.

All booths must have a hand washing station in accordance to Health Department standards.

All booths must have a working and certified Class K fire extinguisher.

All vendors must have a Health Permit from the City of Kilgore or other recognized Texas city.

All cups, plates, bowls, napkins, and utensils must be non-glass and disposable.

Vendors are responsible for the remittance of Sales tax to the State of Texas.

The City of Kilgore disclaims liability for damages or losses due to fire, theft, accident, vandalism or other causes. The City of Kilgore will not be responsible for electrical or other related failures. Exhibitors wishing to insure their goods must do so at their own expense. The exhibitor shall at all times protect, indemnify, save and hold harmless the City of Kilgore against any and all loss, damage, liability or expense occurring out of any incidence which arises out of exhibitor's occupancy and use of the event premises during or subsequent to the period of the exhibition.
